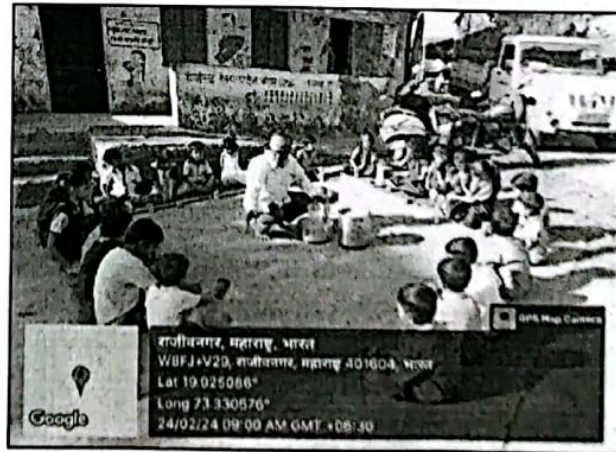

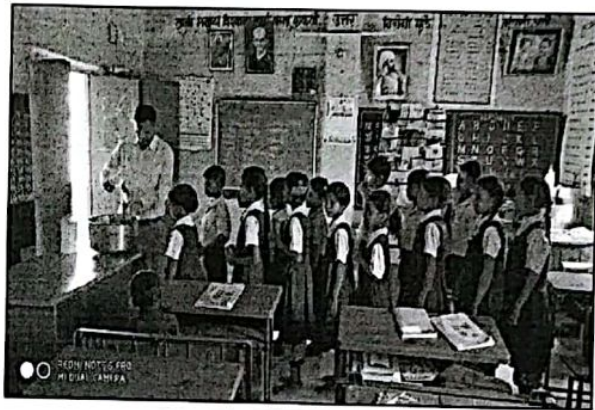

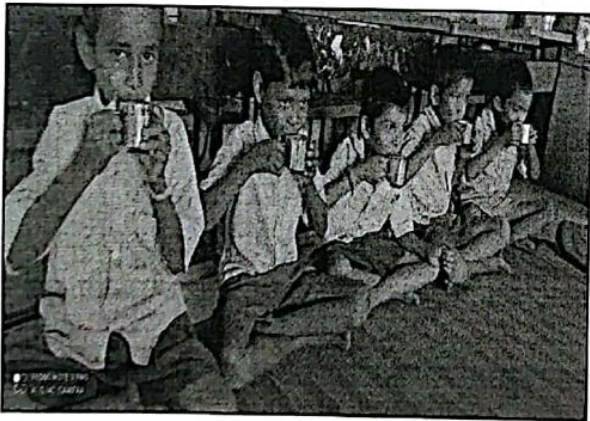

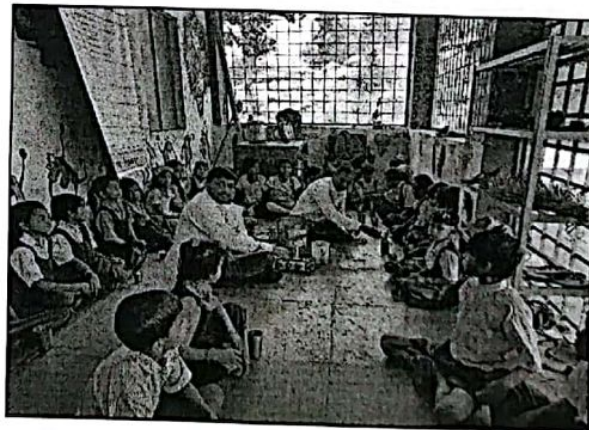

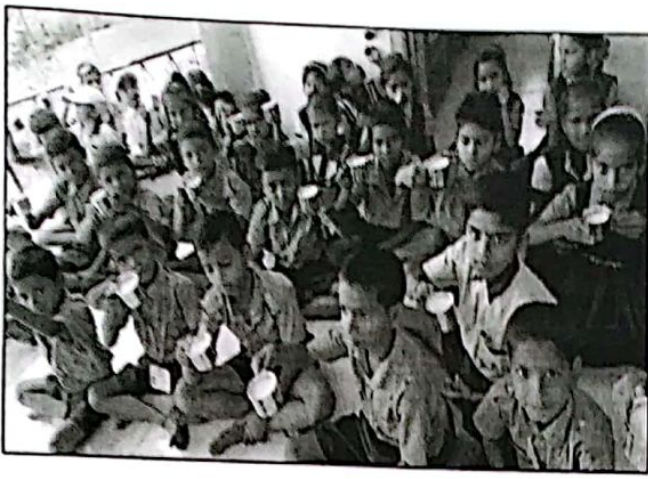


Distribution of Milk at Z.P. Kawalpada

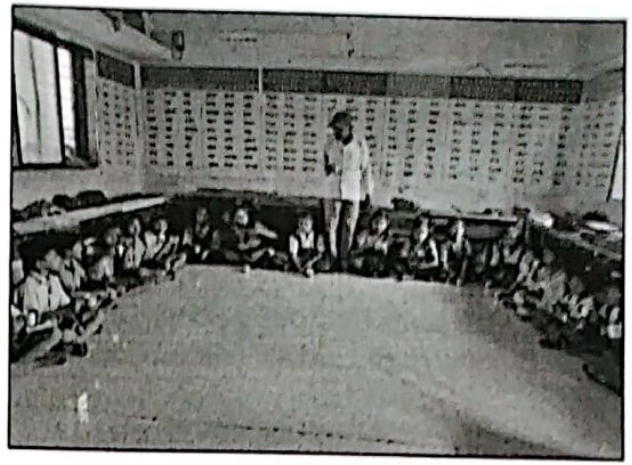


Distribution of Milk at Z.P. Ghosali

Report on Digital Saksharta Centre

2023-24

The COVID-19 pandemic brought out starkly the digital divide in the country. While digital literacy was considered to be a choice and privilege in the past for the selective few, it manifested into a necessity in the last 2+ years. The sudden onset of the pandemic in March 2020 had us hoping that the situation would be temporary and that children would soon go back to school. However, the reality was hard-hitting. Students did not attend school physically for a prolonged period, and those in the rural areas suffered the most with no access or affordability to learn virtually.

Objective –

Given this backdrop, Arts, Science and Commerce College, Mokhada conceptualized the Digital Saksharta Centre project with the objective to bridge the digital divide in rural areas, by imparting computer literacy to children. As a step further, the project also aims to train youth from rural areas in professional IT certificate courses for better employability.

Project Progression –

July, 2021 to December 2021 –

- Community meetings and baseline assessment
- Partner(s) - Evaluation, selection and onboarding – NIIT Foundation selected and onboarded
- Project Site – Evaluation, identification – Rayat Shikshan Sanstha's Arts, Science and Commerce Senior College, Mokhada, Palghar finalized with written consensus from college authorities
- Repairs, renovation and set-up – initiated in November 2021, the renovation work started with replacing the building roof and included civil repairs, water-proofing, painting – internal and external, false ceiling, partition, IT set up, furniture, battery room, generator set-up among others.

January, 2022 to March, 2022 –

- Currently the project team has 3 members including Centre-Head, IT Trainer and Community Mobilizer.
- Students Mobilization and Batch Formation – More than 120 students from the College and nearby schools and Ashramshalas.
- Courses Planning and Design – Based on their expertise and experience, NIIT Foundation and Arts, Science and Commerce College Mokhada has designed the following courses for the Centre –

Digital saksharata center admitted 786 students in FY 2023-24. So inclusion of women in it was very good.

The new change is that this year we also gave digital education to 13 parents, and also gave guidance to 11 Anganwadi sevakas on Financial Literacy & Digital Literacy as well as cyber security (how to beware of Fraud in the current online era).

Also, the foundation of the seedling should be strong. And in order to increase the importance of digital education, we have made a new change i.e. ZP Central school Mokhada in this school (55, 64, 7) 155 students of 3 classes have got digital education and out of all this students have successfully completed course in the whole year. And they got the certificate. There were 381 females → 398 males. And through this we have successfully provided employment to 35 applicants.
