**Report of Analysis of Feedback on the academic performance and ambience of the institution from various stakeholders:**

**Students Feedback about syllabus:**

In Higher Education system the students are the most important stakeholders. The student interest and participation in both internal quality assurance and external quality assurance have to play a central role. To know opinion of students about their curriculum, college has collected online feedback forms from under graduate students. We have received 85 online feedback of students on the syllabus of the various programs designed by the University of Mumbai, Mumbai.

**Students Feedback about Teacher:**

To know the opinion of student about teacher, college has collected online feedback from under graduate students. We have received 125 online feedback of students on the teacher of the college. 50.04 % students says that 85 to 100% syllabus was covered. 89.6 % students says that teachers are always effectively communicate with them.

The college is affiliated to the Mumbai University, Mumbai and follows the prescribed curriculum. We have received 15 online feedback of teacher on curriculum to know the suggestions for improvement of the syllabus.

#### Employers Feedback:

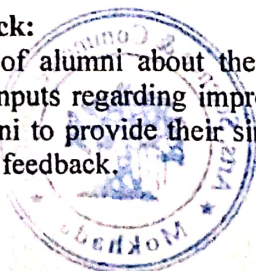
For the success of any educational institution the employer feedback is the most important determinant. The examination of the feedback collected for the year opened up the following information.
